About the Mental Health Professionals Network

The Mental Health Professionals Network (MHPN) is a project funded by the Federal Government to support the development of interdisciplinary collaboration between mental health clinicians working in primary health care.

This project represents a major opportunity to introduce a fundamental shift in the way mental health professions work together to improve consumer outcomes and workforce sustainability, as well as provide a basis for establishing highly effective multidisciplinary support networks and education across the various professional groups working in the mental health sector at a local level.

2. Key Deliverables & Accountabilities

Each Project Officer (PO) has an allocated 'case load' of network coordinators across Australia who lead established or newly created MHPN networks. A key aspect of the role is to provide tailored and strategic administrative support to each coordinator to ensure the networks' sustainability and viability that includes:

- 1. Providing tailored support through negotiated arrangements with each network coordinator which defines roles and responsibilities such as:
 - I. providing strategic advice and support to coordinators to ensure network sustainability
 - II. supporting network members through assisting meetings, planning, preparation and follow up
 - III. providing advice and assistance to secure guest speakers, venue hire and catering
 - IV. managing and coordinating network budgets



- V. promoting MHPN's inter-disciplinary professional development webinars.
- 2. Maintaining network data in the Access database through constant updating of network information and statistics
- 3. Working with the project team to problem solve, develop solutions and action plans including but not limited to the following:
 - I. engaging and supporting a clinical mix of identified core clinicians in networks
 - II. supporting the engagement and inclusion of additional members to networks
 - III. reinvigorating networks that have become inactive through direct contact with network leaders and members
 - IV. establishing new networks which align with the MHPN's strategic priorities.
- 4. Contribute to MHPN reports by preparing reports based on network data as required
- 5. Contribute to effective team work through collaboration and support to team members
- 6. Contribute to MHPNs communications and social media environments, including promotion and marketing to various health audiences.
- 7. Undertaking other duties necessary subject to operational requirements.
